- ✓ 66. a difference between predatory attack (not angry) and affective ag.
- ✓ 66b. 7 classes of ag.
- ✓ 66c. predat. ag - object specific.
- ✓ 67. (a) intra male ag - against strange male.
- ✓ 67b. fear induced ag - when escape impossible.
- ✓ 67c. irritable ag. (anger, rage) object irrelevant.

- o specific more likely to be attacked.
- ✓ 67e. maternal ag. = threat to the young.
- ✓ 67f. instrumental ag. = learned response.
- ✓ 67g. probable: sex related to ag. = aggressive responses and brain activity of the same stimuli did produce usual response. (Too little is known)
- ✓ 68. (a) Pred. ag. Different neurological basis for all others.
- ✓ 68b. pred. attack qualitatively different from affective attack as different brain topography.
- ✓ 69. Hunger not essential for pred. ag.
- ✓ 70. Summary on pred. ag.
- ✓ 71. Int. Sum. intra male ag. - dependent on male hormone.
- ✓ 72. Sum. fear ag. - indications that different neurological basis for others.
- ✓ 72b. Irritable ag. - uncontrollable rage.
- ✓ 73. Irr. ag - Sum - increased by any stressor
