127 great majority of anthropologists were accept

128 Australopithecus africanus.  
generally omitted Pleistocene species (possibly P. aegyptiacus)

129. First specimen in Tanzania in Butchery 1924; Raymond  
Dart.

At first system & put it later in a family between  
hominids & pongids. after examining dentition  
concluded that hominids.

At first majority: many men like open  
later more accepted as hominid.

estimated f 2-1 million years.

131 Ten years later R. Broome, at Sterkfontein (Transvaal)  
now considered Austral. Af.

132 There is evidence that it is human.

133 1938 Sterkfontein valley also Broome found other fossils

Paranthropus robustus.

140 Broome 1949. 1/2 - 1 mill yrs. the a few  
rather claim that robustus is larger than a few.
