- 16 paraventricular part of the brain: processes  
similarity of sex & aggression
- 18 Academic explanation: either response to frustration or  
learned. Third part of brain: response to threat & specifically  
human aggression
- 21 aggressive drive only objectionable when blocked!
- 22. Va. Mittel up: aggression - destruction etc.  
Aggression not destruction because serves survival!
- 23. Animal kill only for food - lion not a prey
- 25. dominance leads to peace
- 26. If man were not aggressive he would not be man at all
- 34. Like animal man acts badly & over-crowding?
- 34. Inflicting death (Africa, Russia?)  
is rare among animals (H. H. S. 1948)
- 34. majority of fights are ritual - not dangerous battles?
- 36. aggressive drive serves the function of instinct.
