Freud 69 1909: n. necessary intermediate between autoerotism & object love

73. ↓ n. = sexual perversion. (at first)

73/4 ↓ n. = libidinal component complement to the egoism of the instinct of self-preservation.

74. In schizophrenia - diversion of interest for external world, + megalomania.

75. Libido withdrawn from external world to the ego (sexual autoerotic).

76. antithesis between ego libido and object libido.

76. Freud is not postulate a single kind of psychical energy.

77. Ego-libido and object-libido

80. ascetic ascetic may have vitiated his sexual interests for human beings, although entirely, yet substitute it with heightened interest in the Divine.

82. Access to narcissism mainly in psychosis.

Other ways: study of organic disease, hypochondria, hectic life of the sexes.

[Freud's statement that sickness stops love is only relatively true for most people. In principle pain does not lead to stopping of love. This is important for Freud's problem of love, as feasible.

Sleep as narcissistic is questionable. In a dream one can love or hate; one is only withdrawn from outside reality.

96 ego-ideal (or ideal man) - results from critical influence
of parents.

96 homosexual libido drawn into formation of narcissistic ego ideal.

98 Self-regard: everything a person possesses or achieves, any remnant of omnipotence & confidence helps to increase his self-regard. - S-R. dependence on narcissistic libido.

99 Loving lowers self-regard, being loved raises it.

If the whole concept of love based on possession principle,

100%: object type being in love in fulfillment of infantile conditions for love.

what possesses the excellence that the ego looks for making it an ideal, is loved.
