145. *psychical* id = "contains everything that is inherited, that is present at birth, that is laid down in the constitution - above all, therefore, the instincts, still ungrate from the somatic organization and still find a first physical expression here [in the id] in forms unknown to us."

146. "The arising of these tensions is in general felt as unpleasure or their lowering as pleasure. It is probable, however, that what is felt as pleasure or unpleasure is not the absolute height of this tension but something of the rhythm in the changes in them. The ego strives after pleasure and seeks to avoid unpleasure."
