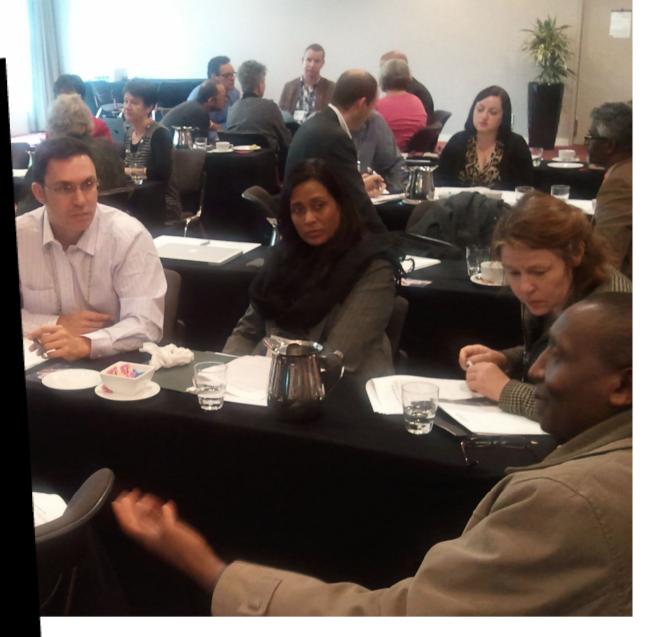

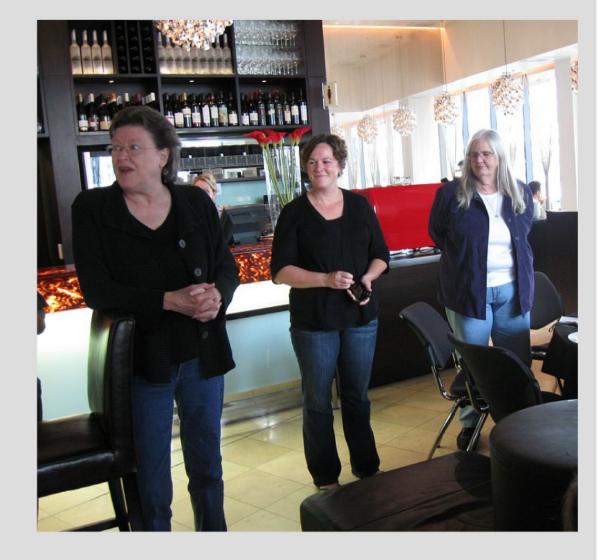

The Basics: Assess Your Risk Tolerance (May 1-7)

In this module, we are going to be focusing on your responses to taking risks in your work environment. Very few of you are in a position to significantly change the risk tolerance of the organizations in which you work. Therefore, you will be spending most of your time considering your personal reactions to risk and learning how to operate effectively in your work environment. That process will start in this topic with two personality assessments.

- Risk-Type Compass™ Questionnaire: "Two key factors determine a person's approach to risk. Firstly, there are
 aspects of their natural temperament that will establish their general reaction to any kind of risk or uncertainty (Risk
 Type). Secondly, risk tolerance is modified by experience and personal circumstances and this will influence [a
 person's] attitude towards different areas of risk (Risk Attitude)." [PsyKey Online Assessmerts]. The Risk-Type
 Compass™ questionnaire includes questions that will measure both your risk type and your risk attitude.
- The Five Personalities of Innovators: Which One Are You?: This article describes the findings from Forbes
 Insights' recent study, Nurturing Europe's Spirit of Enterprise: How Entrepreneurial Executives Mobilize Organizations
 to Innovate. [The study] "isolates and identifies five major personalities crucial to fostering a healthy, and some more
 process-oriented but all play a critical role in the process. To wit: thinkers need doers to get things done, and idealists
 need number crunchers to tether them to reality." [The Five Personalities of Innovators: Which One Are You?]

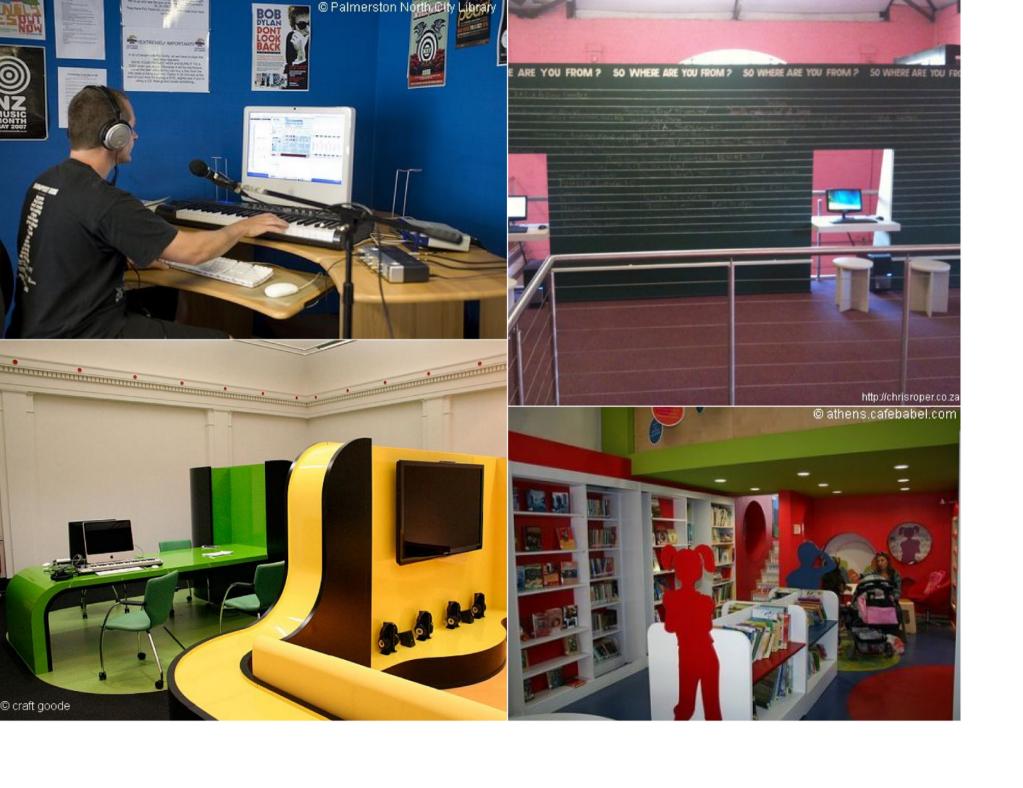
