
Anforderungsanalyse | Vorgehen

- Wissenschaftler:innen
 - Online-Umfrage (SoSci Survey)
 - 884 Datensätze ausgewertet
 - breite Abdeckung Disziplinen, Erfahrungsstufen (years in science, number of papers)
- Publikationsberatung an Bibliotheken
 - qualitative Interviews
- Verlage, Publikationsplattformen, scholar-led journals
 - explorative Interviews



Anforderungsanalyse | Erkenntnisse

- Anhaltspunkte für Spezifikation des Empfehlungssystems
 - Filter, Journalprofile, lokale Einbindung/Anpassung
 - z.B. Nutzungsrechteverbleib, Publikationskosten, DOI, Vertrauenswürdigkeit
- Heterogenität: Disziplin, Karrierestufe, Einrichtungstyp
- Community-Faktor, Personen als Qualitätsmerkmal


