She shared the 2019 Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Sciences with Abhijit Banerjee and Michael Kremer, for their experimental approach to alleviating global poverty. Duflo is a National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER) research associate, a board member of the Bureau for Research and Economic Analysis of Development (BREAD), and director of the Centre for Economic Policy Research's development economics program. Her research focuses on microeconomic issues in developing countries, including household behavior, education, access to finance, health, and policy evaluation. Together with Abhijit Banerjee, Dean Karlan, Michael Kremer, John A. List and Sanchit Mullainathan, she has been a driving force in advancing field experiments as an important methodology to discover causal relationships in economics. Together with Abhijit Banerjee, she wrote Poor Economics and Good Economics for Hard Times, published in April 2011 and November 2019, respectively. 

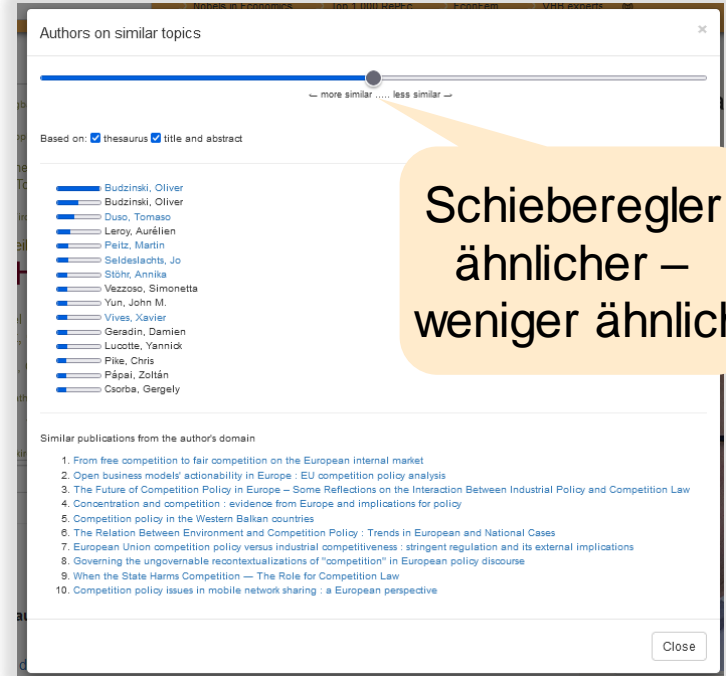


**Abstract (EN)** Name ambiguity of authors is a long-standing challenge in Digital Libraries. Simple string searches for authors often have unsatisfactory results: publications by the author in which their name is written differently cannot be found, and publications by other authors of the same name get included. The authors can be distinguished with the use of persistent identifiers. This improves the search function and also contributes to the data linking process. But many catalogs of libraries are not fully disambiguated and it is not feasible for big libraries like the ZBW - Leibniz Information Centre for Economics to disambiguate the bibliographic records manually. The goal of this work is to help the ZBW with their disambiguation task. For this purpose I analysed the datasets of the ZBW and identified the challenges that





## EconBiz Author Profiles

Researchers, libraries and other institutions use authority files in order to make it easier to identify individual persons or institutions. The use of authority files helps to identify the right person if you have two or more people who share the same name (e.g. John Smith born in 1950 versus John Smith born in 1972 or John Smith, the economist, versus John Smith, the dancer). On the other hand authority files are used to bring together publications by one author whose publications appear under different names e.g. due to marriage or due to different spellings in different languages, common spelling mistakes, use of initials etc. (e.g. William D. Nordhaus, W. D. Nordhaus, U. Nordchaut, W. Nordhaus, William Nordhaus Weilian Nuodehaosi, 威廉·诺德豪斯).

This service integrated several other services such as: LOBID, Entity Facts, EconBiz API, Nobel Prize API, RePEc top authors, Wikidata and DBPedia.

EconBiz Author Profiles can be used to find more information on specific authors. Authors themselves can use it to see how others make use of named entities or linked data.

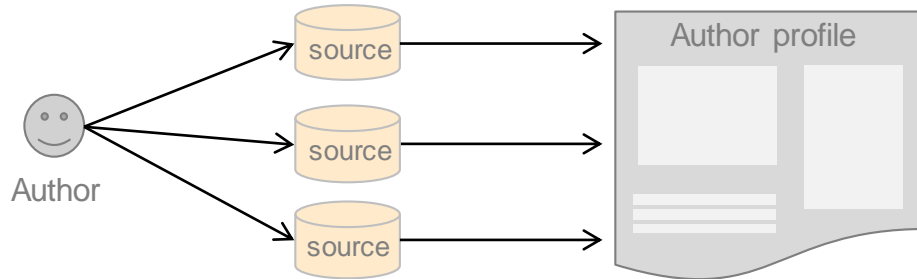

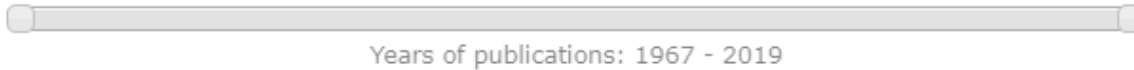
