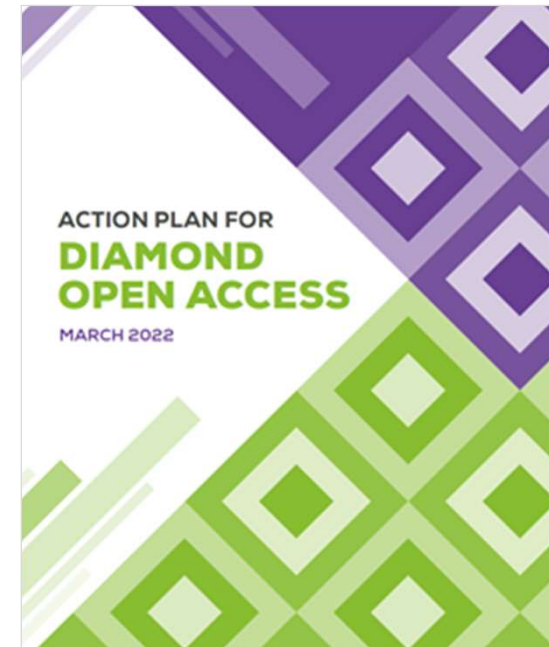

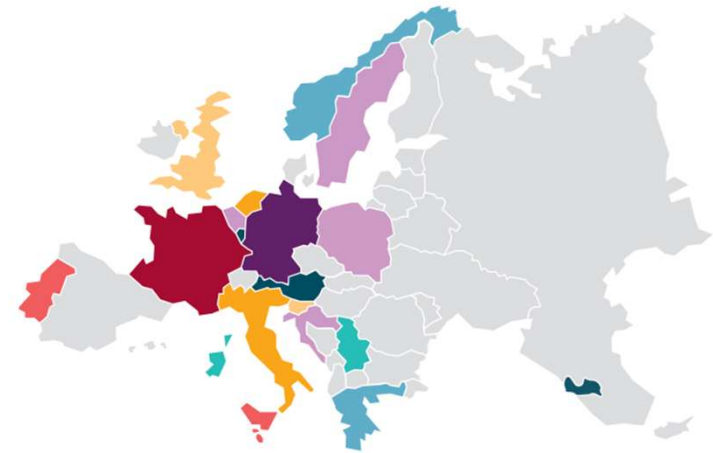
Vision sucht Umsetzung

Die Vision operationalisieren: OPERAS

- OPERAS - **O**pen scholarly communication in the **E**uropean **r**esearch **a**rea for **s**ocial sciences and humanities
- Ziel ist die nachhaltige Verbesserung der Publikationsinfrastruktur, vor allem für textorientierte Disziplinen
- Netzwerk von aktuell 50 europäischen Institutionen und Verbänden (z.B. AEUP, MWS, DARIAH)
- federführend in diversen EU-Projekten
- Beteiligung an oder Verantwortung für Services wie DOAB, Prism, GoTriple

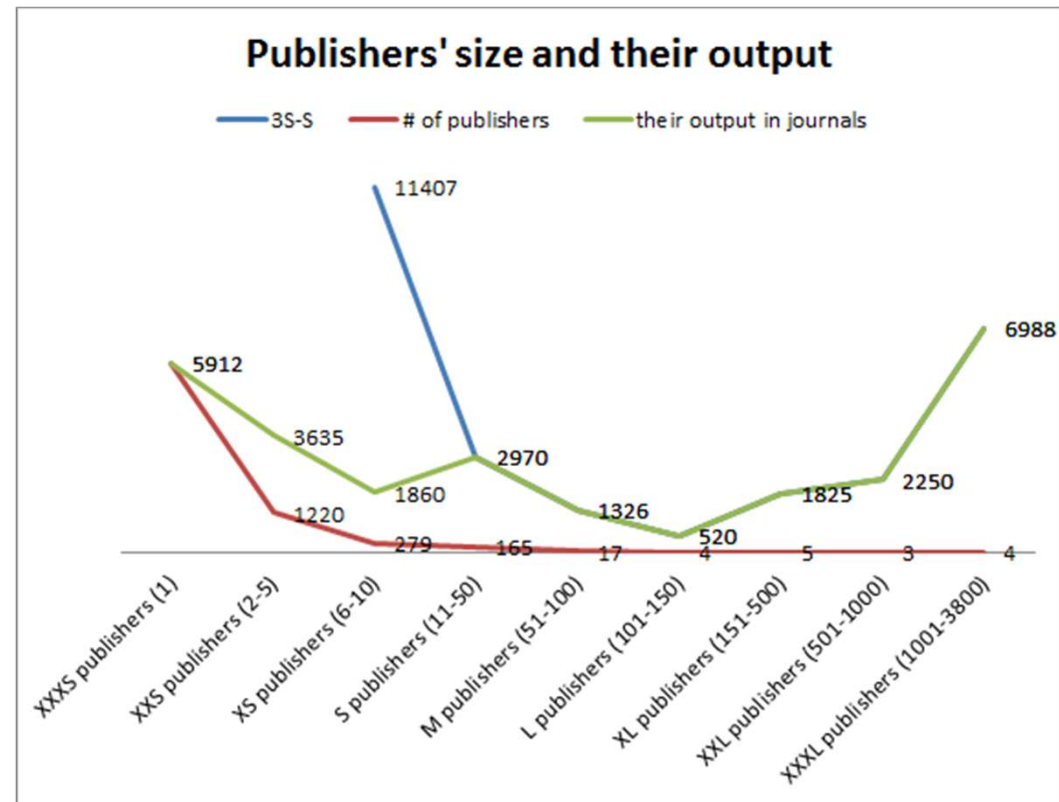

Die Realität

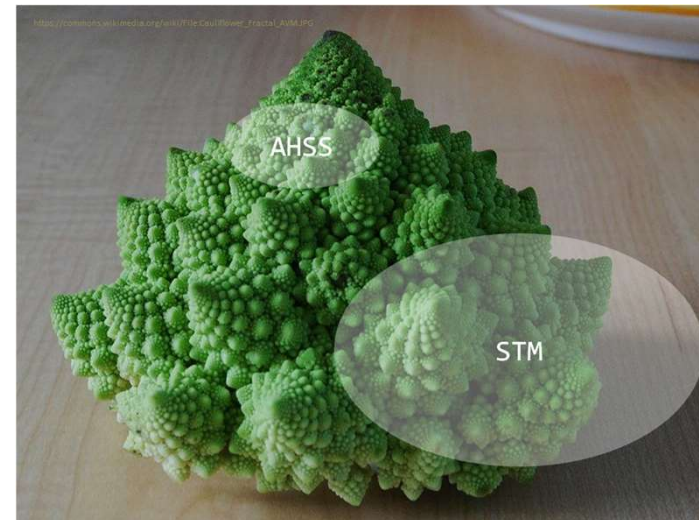
- Marktdominanz der Großverlage
- Budgetaufwände der Bibliotheken überproportional in der XXL-Sphäre
- Der Output der vernachlässigten "Kleinen" ist gesamthaft überraschend groß
- Institutionelles und Diamond Open Access vor allem in der Sphäre der 3S-M publishers

Ebenfalls die Realität

- Standardisierung, Sichtbarkeit und Interoperabilität vor allem von den "großen" Disziplinen geprägt
- Reputationsgewinn weiterhin entlang konventioneller Paradigmen, auch durch Dominanz der Großverlage in den Nachweissystemen
- Bei kleinen Verlagen und Einzeljournals (3S-S) überproportional viel Aufwand pro Journal notwendig, technische Reife, Sichtbarkeit und Akzeptanz zu gewinnen
- Geringe Größe korreliert — in manchen Aspekten — mit unzuänglicher Nachweissituation und damit Problemen von Sichtbarkeit und Anerkennung
- Technische Reife profitiert von "economy of scale"

Council calls for transparent, equitable, and open access to scholarly publications

Today the Council has adopted conclusions on the 'high quality, transparent, open, trustworthy and equitable scholarly publishing', in which it calls for immediate and unrestricted open access in publishing research involving public funds.



If we really believe in open science, we need to make sure that researchers can make their findings available and re-usable and that high-quality scientific articles are openly accessible to anyone that needs to read them. This should be particularly the case for research that benefits from public funding: what has been paid by all should be accessible to all.

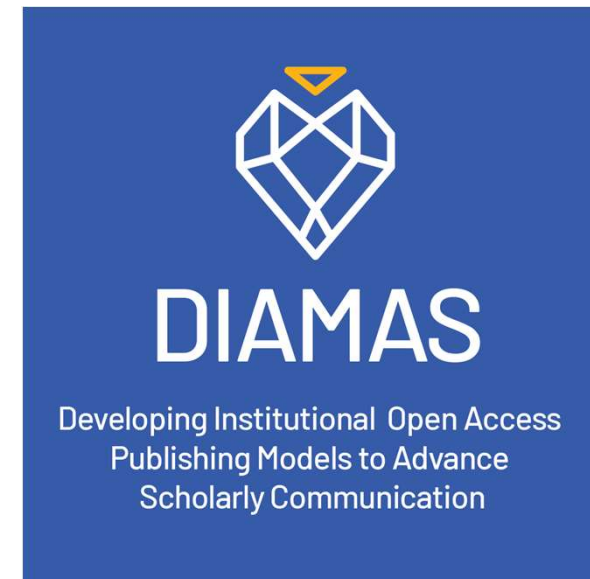
The hazards of scholarly publishing

NOTES that the current system of scholarly publishing is operated by various for-profit and not-for-profit organisations and RECOGNISES with concern that the increasing costs of paywalls for access to scientific publications and for scholarly publishing cause inequalities and are becoming unsustainable for public research funders and institutions accountable for the spending of public funds, decreasing funding available for research;

HIGHLIGHTS the importance of not-for-profit, scholarly open access publishing models that do not charge fees to authors or readers and where authors can publish their work without funding/institutional eligibility criteria; NOTES the variety of models that do not depend on article processing charges or similar per-unit charges and STRESSES the importance of supporting the development of such models led by public research organisations;

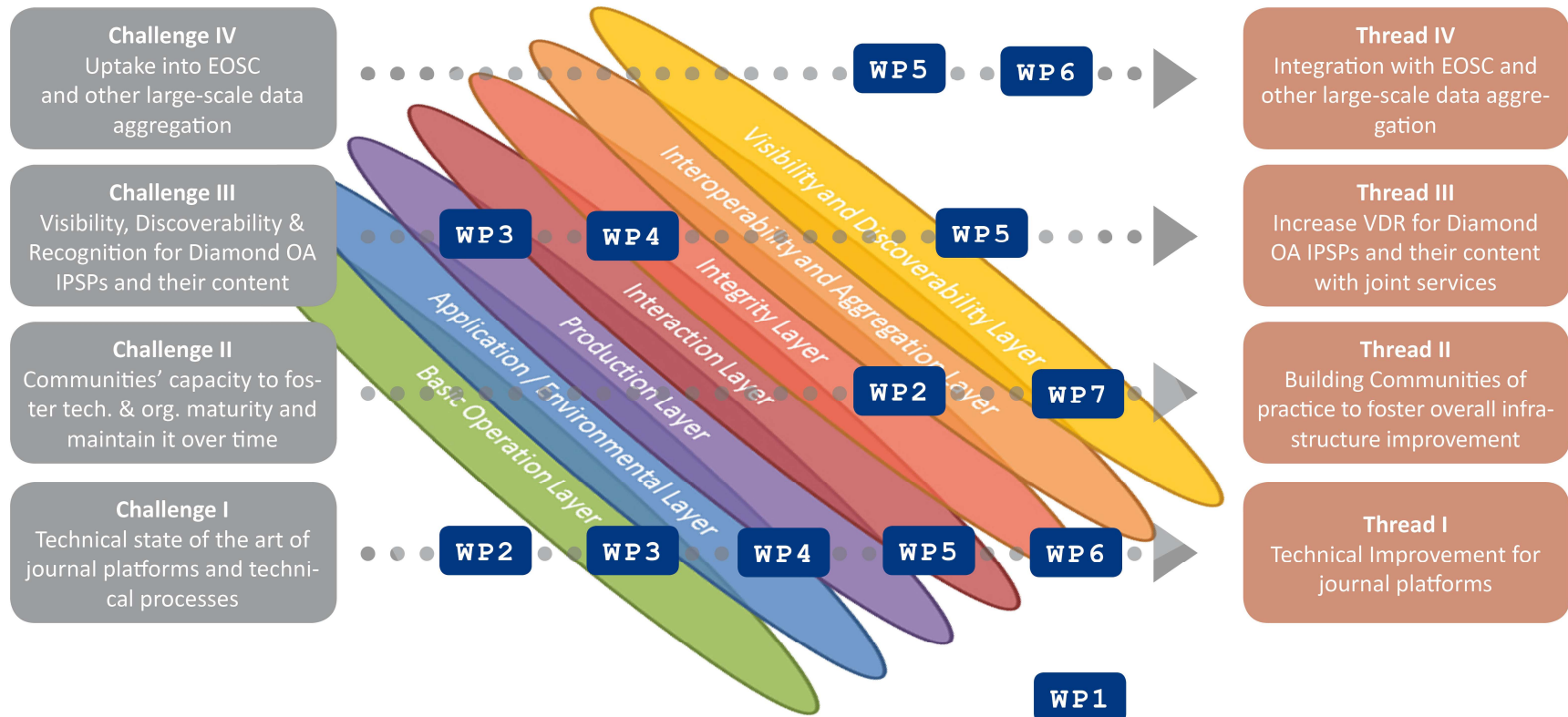
