NYHETER	<h3 style="color: #0056b3;">What does the "Library Lovers" logo stand for?</h3> <p>The Swedish Library Association is conducting a campaign which will last until the General Election of 2010 and whose aim is to increase political commitment to publicly financed libraries. Sweden is the only Nordic country that does not have a national library policy. Consequently, Swedes do not have access to the full potential to be derived from a world-leading library system.</p> <p>The lack of a concerted political stand in support of libraries has led to an alarming situation. Four hundred local public libraries have been closed down and 450,000 pupils are deprived of a staffed school library. There are fewer visitors to libraries, the number of book loans is decreasing, and the level of reading comprehension is sinking. 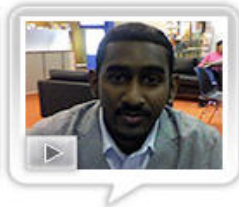
