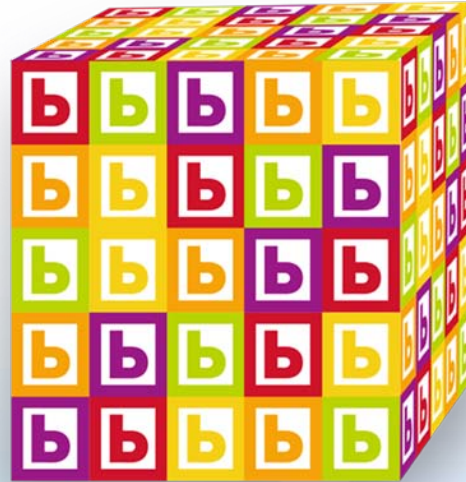

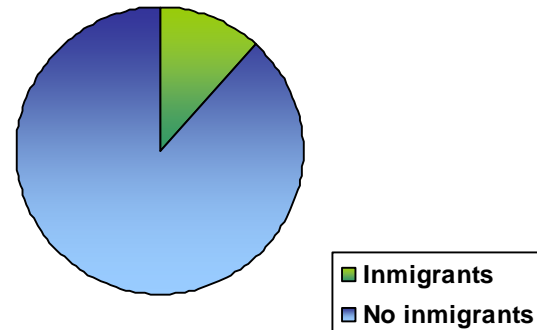

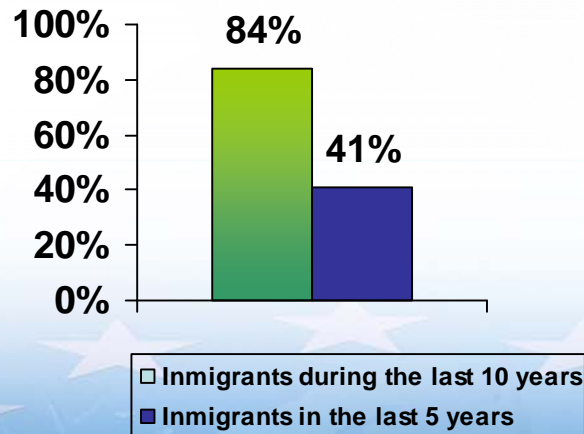

# National Reading, Book and Library Act 10/2007

## Goals

- To promote a balanced, coherent, progressive and innovative development for all the Spanish libraries, nets, systems and consortiums.
- To promote the use of ICT in all the library services and to develop skills to facilitate their use between citizens.
- To promote equal access to a quality public library service in the whole country.



## Main contributions

- Defines the Library System as a whole of library cooperation relations.
- Specifies the aims to achieve by the State General Administration.
- Adds the european project of digital libraries to the Spanish Legislation
- Describes the way of normalize and coordinate the libraries belonging to the State Administration





This important law has developed two new regulations with the objective to create two cooperation and coordination structures.

These regulations are vital to rally the Spanish Library System:



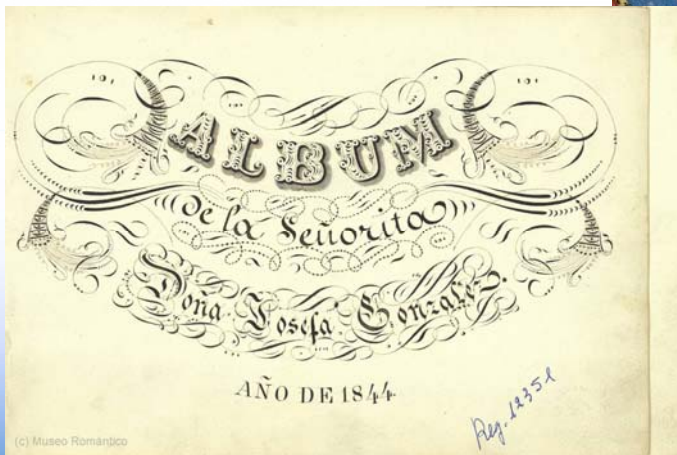
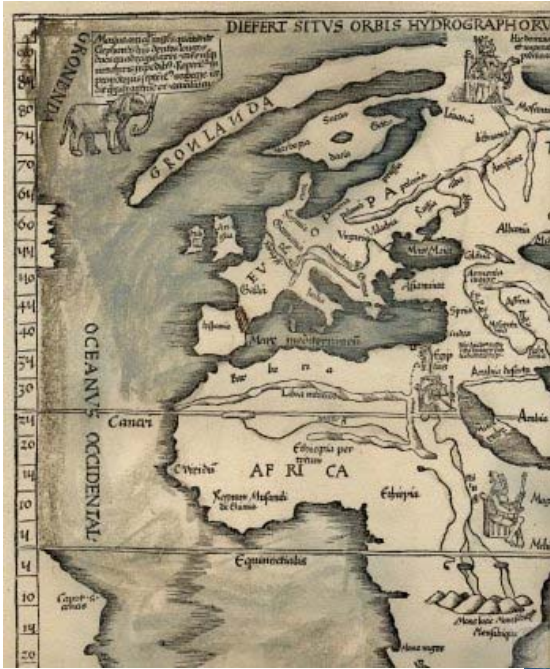
# RD 1572/2007 Regulating the Coordination of the State General Administration Libraries

- + 800 State Libraries  
Most of these libraries are special libraries
- Coordination bodies:
  - General Coordination body
  - An Specific body for each Department or Ministry

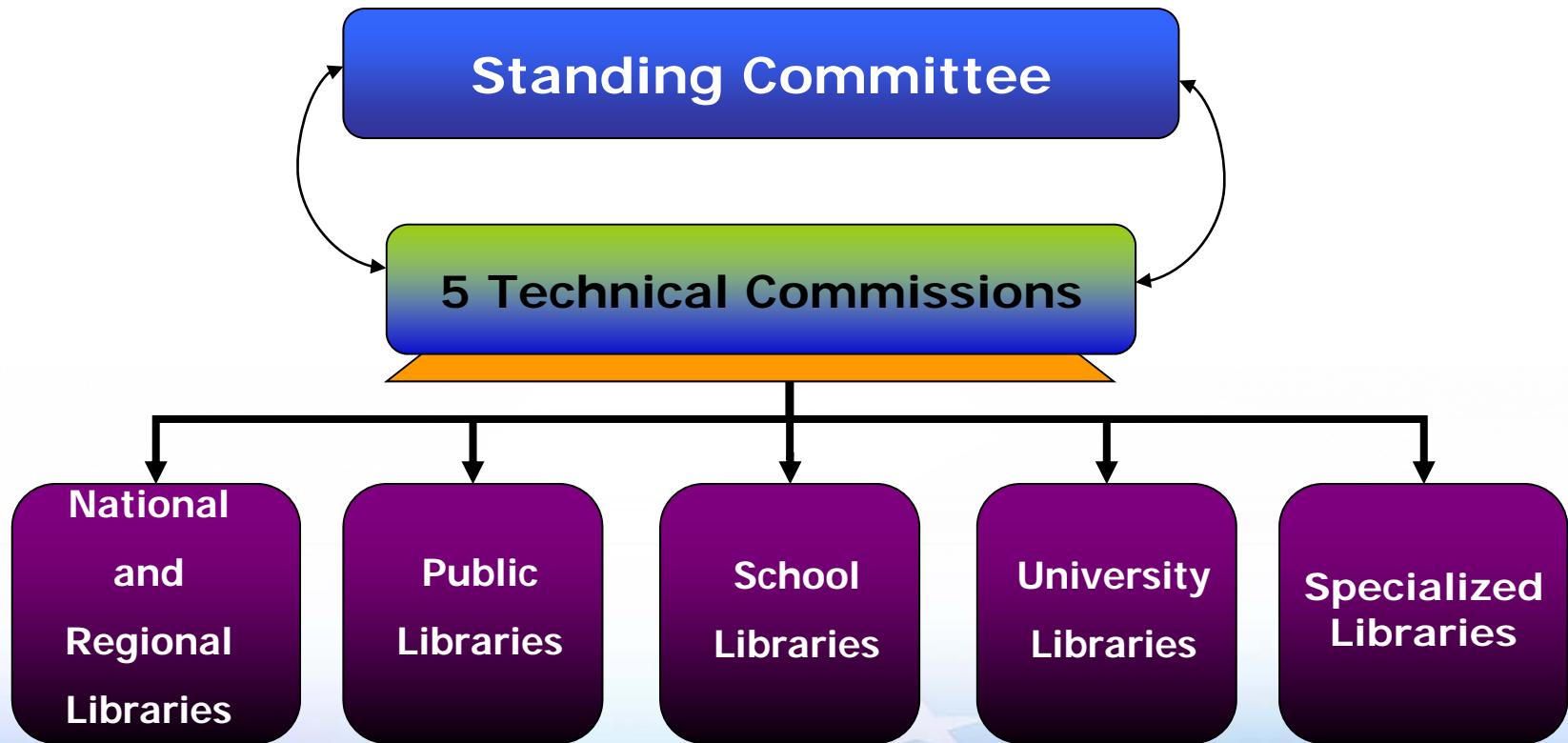
# RD 153/2007. Library Cooperation Council Regulation

- The Library Cooperation Council is an interadministrative body created to channel the library cooperation between public administrations.

- To prepare library reports and develop projects encomended by the Culture and Education Sectorial Conferences as well as the Rectors Conference of Spanish Universities





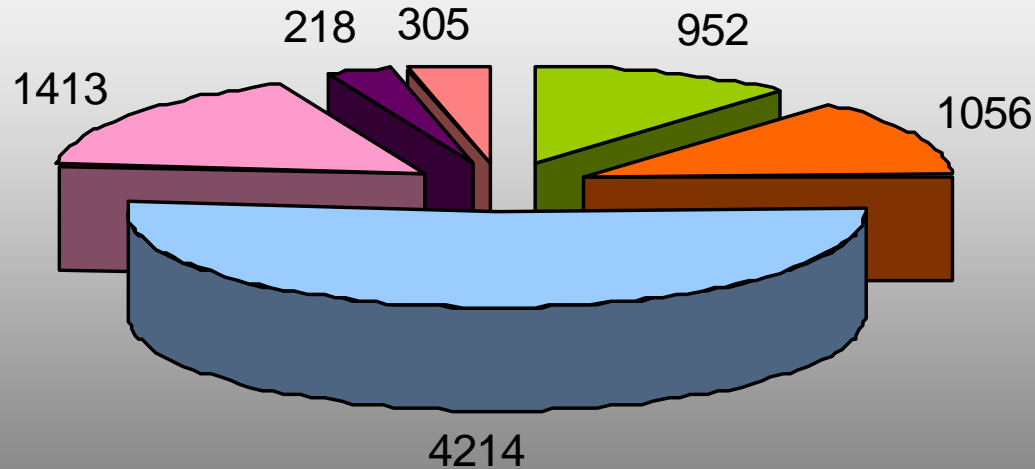
# The Spanish Library System

- **Private libraries (of private Universities, Foundations, Companies, etc.)**

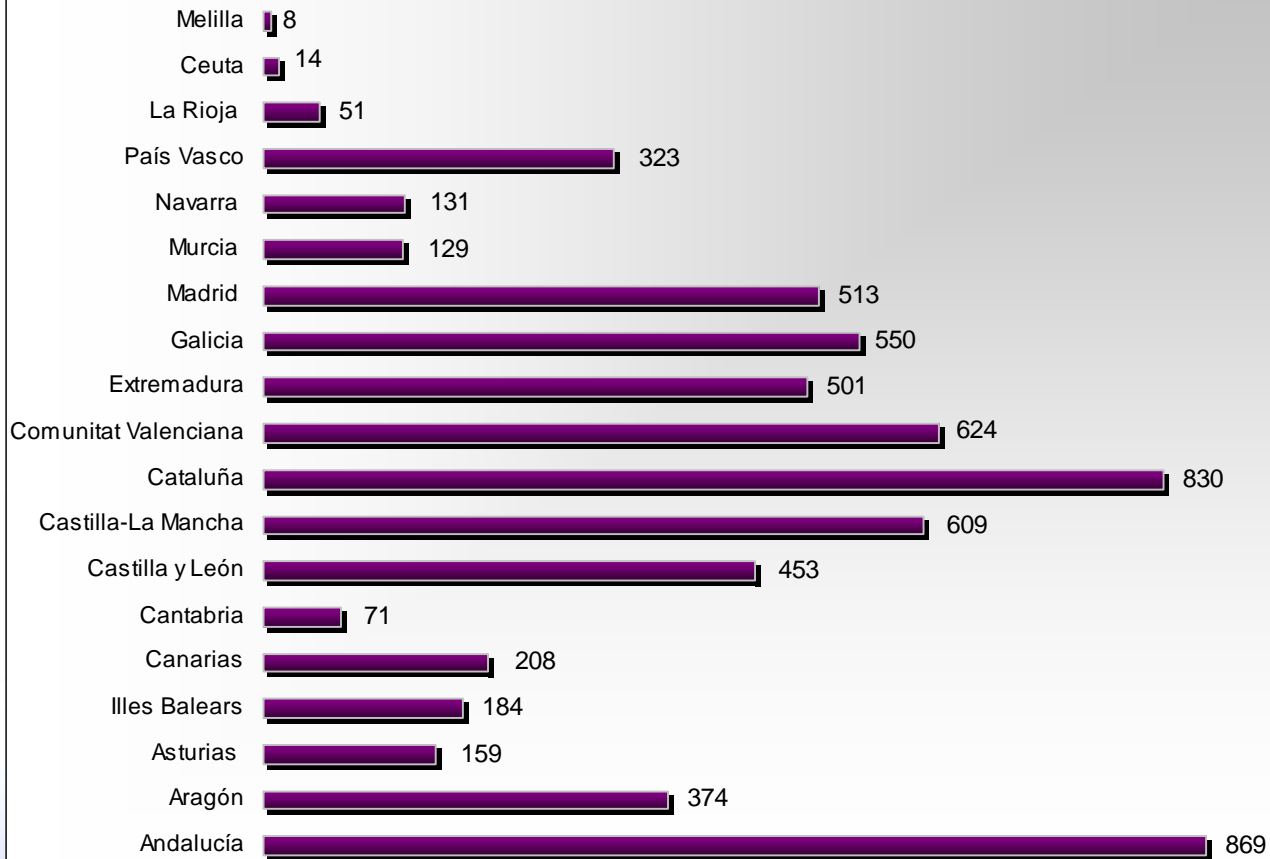

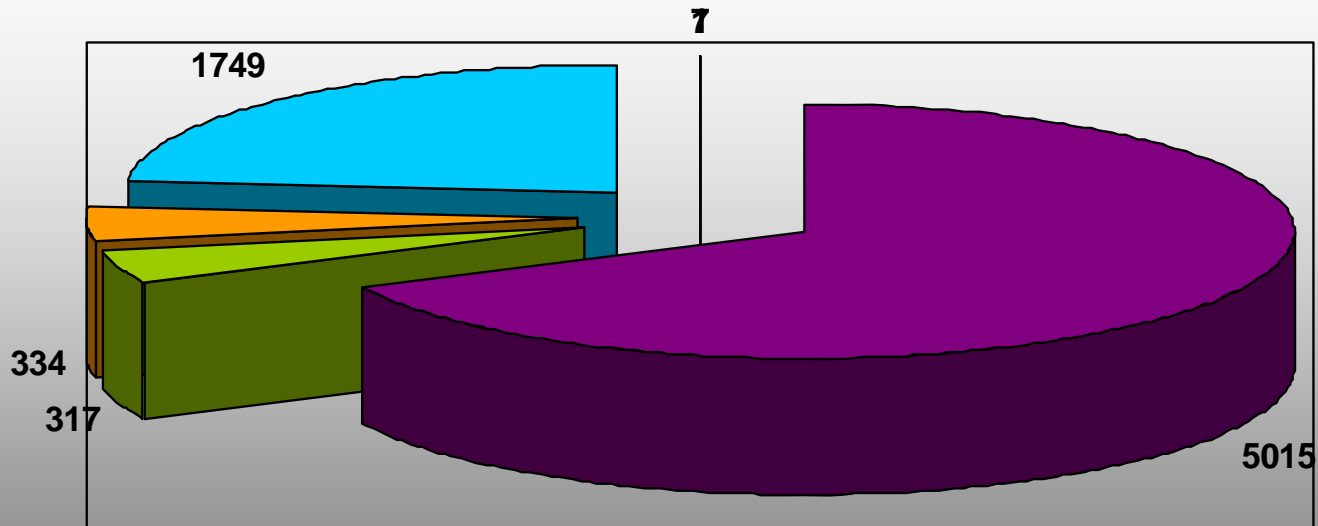

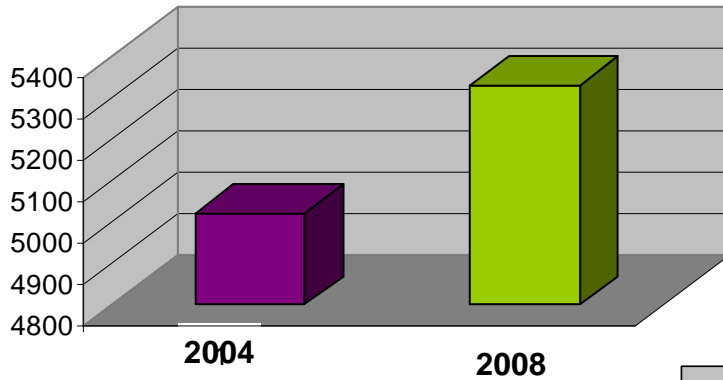

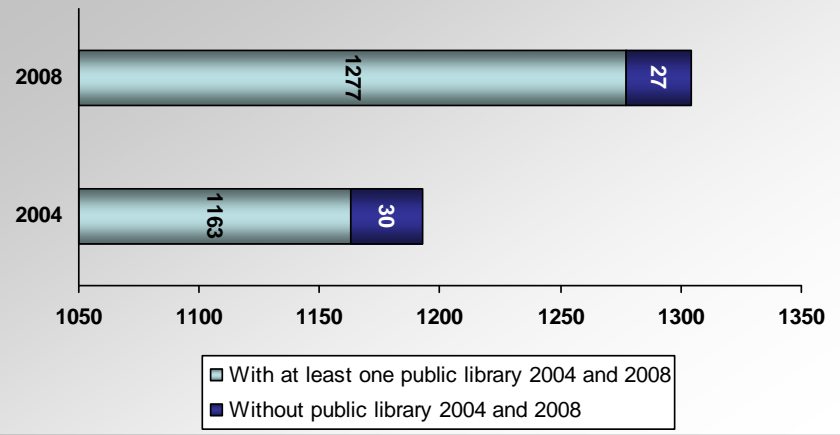

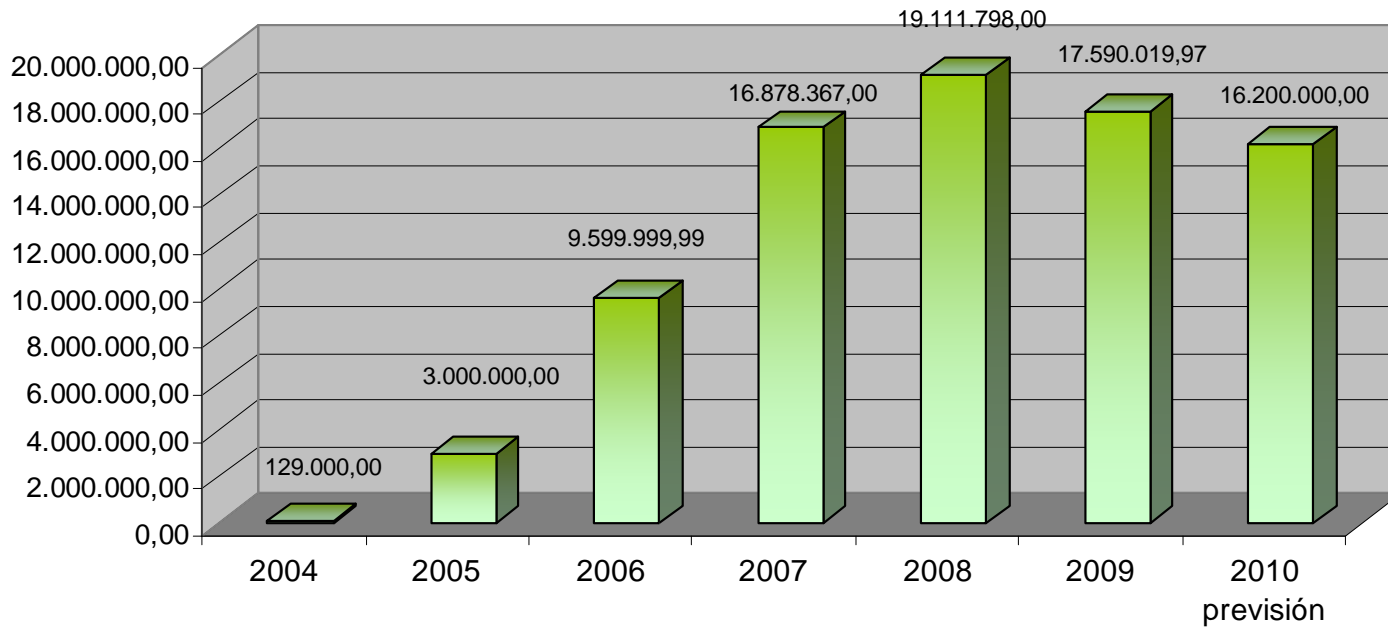

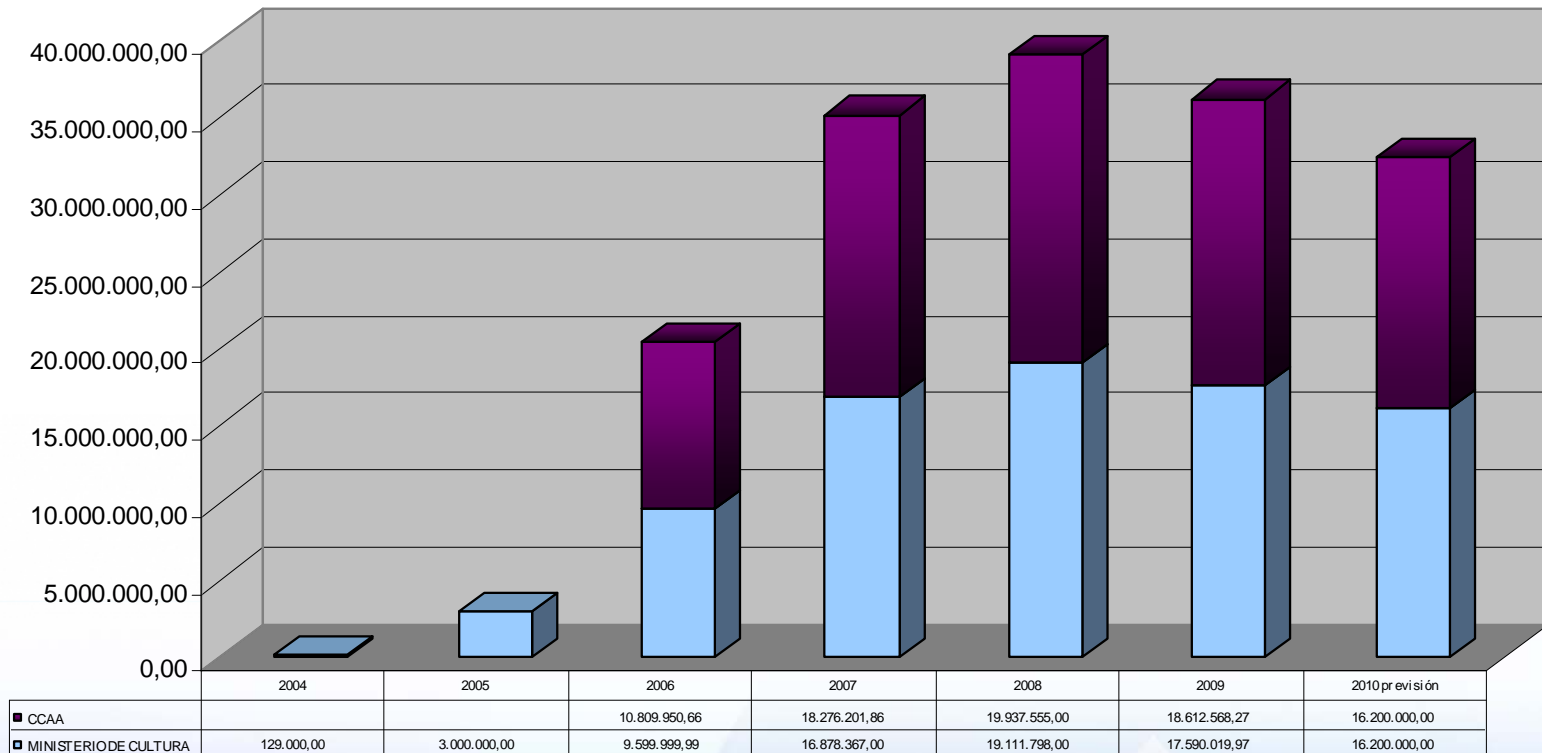

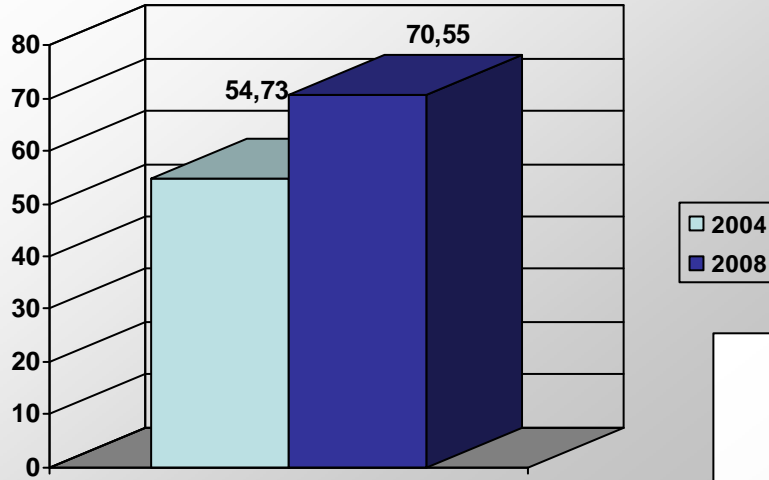

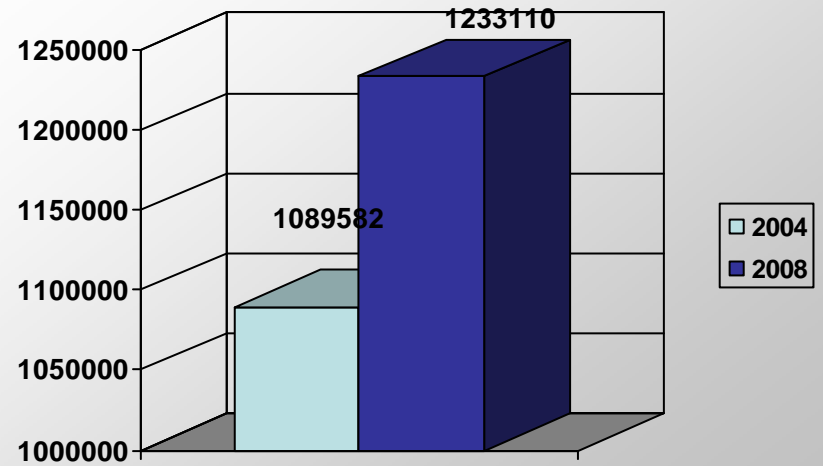

At the joint conference of EBLIDA and NAPLE Forum, held in Vienna in May 2009, it was agreed to strengthen the role and potential of the library service throughout Europe in supporting the European Knowledge Society. Accordingly, EBLIDA and NAPLE Forum call on the European Commission to make progress through four recommendations detailed in the [Vienna Declaration](#).

**Latest news:**

The document is titled "A Library Policy for Europe" and "Vienna Declaration". It outlines four recommendations from the joint conference of EBLIDA and NAPLE Forum in May 2009.

**1. White paper "Public Libraries in the Knowledge Society":**

EBLIDA and NAPLE Forum call on the European Commission to adopt a white paper that describes the new role of public libraries in the European Knowledge Society and recommends and encourages member states to act on behalf of their libraries. The white paper should be based, amongst other input, on the work of a high-level group of libraries established by the Commission.

**2. Knowledge Centre:**

We further call on the European Commission to establish a European Knowledge Centre for public libraries that will provide coordinated, current and reliable information on the public library services in all European member states and the EEA and which will be based at EBLIDA.

**3. European funded projects:**

Foster European funded projects that promote the development of libraries in a meaningful and sustainable way. Projects should target the development of a European library infrastructure that would complement the existing projects with high political visibility. In addition to these highly visible digital library development projects a common infrastructure for public libraries must be developed in order to accelerate the uptake of newly created online services and promote active European citizenship, as well as to provide wide learning opportunities.

**4. Copyright:**

Abolish barriers in the European Union that contradict the idea of the development of a Knowledge Society. A fair copyright policy is required, which considers the meaningful rights of the right-holders, but which at the same time establishes reasonable exceptions for the work of libraries.

EBLIDA is the European Bureau of Library, Information and Documentation Associations, an independent umbrella association of national library, information, documentation and archive associations and institutions in Europe.

NAPLE, National Authorities for Public Libraries in Europe, is an international non-governmental association pursuing the interests of the national library authorities in Europe. Its main aim is to promote principles and strategies for public library policies.

**ANDALUSIA: “Bibliotecas interculturales**



The Intercultural Libraries Project in Andalucía started in 2001. The objective of this programme was to offer access and ensure access to the public library for the increasing immigrant population and the ethnic, linguistic and cultural minorities of the region, by offering them collections and services of their interest as well as promoting the knowledge of their culture among the rest of the library users and presenting the library as a place of cultural interchange.

**MADRID: “Biblioteca abierta”**



In the year 2005 the programme Open Library, a programme of Madrid Regional Government, was created with the objective of contributing to the welcome and integration of those immigrants not having Spanish as their main language. At first it only included public libraries located in Madrid city, later it has included other libraries from Madrid region.

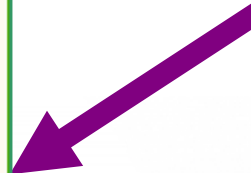
